John the Baptist was Elijah returned

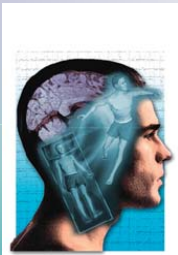

Aim of Reincarnation

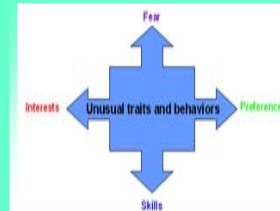
